Dining Hall Roof

We have now finished the new roof for Lakeview Dining Hall, and we are extremely grateful to the 60+ people who helped bring this project to completion! It was an amazing undertaking that was long overdue. We are happy to now have full insulation - 9 inches in the roof (compared to the 2-1/2 inches from 1963), plus new foam under the metal sheeting. We have actually surpassed the recommended minimum R38 for roof insulation, meaning we can look forward to staying warm on cold winter nights for years to come.

The roof looks great with the new windows and doors, and all that remains is to reside and put in a new ceiling, which we will do this coming fall/winter. I am continually amazed at how God provides for us in our times of need. The full story of the roof is too long for this newsletter article, but ask us next time you are here and we can tell you all about God's timing, His provision, and the generosity of many, many people.

We are excited for Summer 2011! Registration is going well, and the program staff are coming up with some amazing new twists for our campers to experience as they come to learn about the life of David, the "Rock Star" of the Old Testament.
