FAMILY CAMP LODGING OPTIONS

RETREAT CENTERS – HOLIDAY WEEKEND FAMILY CAMPS ONLY

(Edlund Retreat Center & Loon Lodge)

Our two retreat centers offer families dorm-style lodging with restrooms & showers inside the building. Room sizes vary, accommodating 2 to 12 people each. Retreat centers are centrally located in Main Camp and close to Lakeview Dining Hall. Families are generally housed one family household per room. Guests bring their own bedding, towels & personal care items. Complete linen sets available for \$10 per person.

Retreat Center guests are required to sign up for a meal package, as cooking & dining facilities are not available in these buildings



EAGLE RIDGE CABINS – HOLIDAY WEEKEND AND FAMILY GETAWAYS

Nestled in the trees along both sides of Eagle Ridge are our 17 cabins (deluxe & rustic). Each cabin sleeps up to 13 people in bunk-style beds and is close to a nearby restroom/shower building. Cabins have cement floors, electric lights and outlets. Families are permitted to share cabin cost, but each must pay their own registration fee. Our 11 deluxe cabins have recently been remodeled with new interior and exterior upgrades such as air conditioning, heating, new lights, windows, doors and log siding. Cooking is allowed outside cabins. Picnic table, fire ring and firewood available with advance request.

FAMILY CAMPGROUNDS – HOLIDAY WEEKEND AND FAMILY GETAWAYS

Our campgrounds feature 4 beautiful sections, with restrooms and showers located nearby. Lakeside – our "group site" includes tent only and electric sites that are on a first come basis. **All other areas may be reserved in advance, including:**

- **Westwood** (21 back-in sites) features electric hook-ups
- **Cottonwood** (8 pull-thru sites) features electric and water hook ups
- **Mill Point** (16 back-in sites) features full hook ups - electric, water & septic

Picnic tables and fire rings are available and may be requested at check-in. One family household per site (includes dad, mom and any unmarried children). Other family members may share the same site, but must pay their own registration separately.

* Please note: state code requires a minimum of 10' between units (does not include portable fabric tents) to allow access for emergency vehicles.

Fire wood will be available at no charge this summer for Family Camp guests. Guests are asked to help slow the spread of tree damaging pests by leaving their firewood at home.
