Youth Camp GENERAL INFORMATION

HOW TO REGISTER:

1. Complete the attached Summer Camp Registration & Health Form.
2. Mail form with your check payable to "Lake Beauty Bible Camp".
3. You may also register ONLINE at lbcc.com.
4. A confirmation letter will be mailed to you which will include activity options, Bring A Friend form, and other helpful information as your child prepares for camp.
5. Complete and return any pre-arrival forms (optional) or do so online at lbcc.com.

EARLY REGISTRATION DISCOUNT PROGRAM

Registrations paid in Full and postmarked on or before April 1st are entitled to a \$20 discount off the normal published rate (Joyful Junior registrations are a \$10 Discount).

PAYMENTS, CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

- Deposit: A \$50 non-refundable deposit is required with each registration.
- Balance Due: The balance is due for all sessions by June 1. Full payment is required for all registrations received after June 1.
- Cancellations & Refunds: Should you need to cancel (from Jan 1-June 1, 2010), all but your \$50 deposit will be refunded to you. No refunds will be made for cancellations after June 1.
- If a camper is unable to attend a session, he/she is allowed to transfer from one age-appropriate session to another within the same summer season. All monies paid will transfer to the new session; OR,
- If a camper is unable to attend a session, all monies paid may be transferred to a new camper who can take his or her place (as space is available).

ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURE

Most Lake Beauty Summer Youth Camps have a standard registration & check-in time of 3:00 to 5:00 pm. Youth camps conclude at 12:30 following the noon meal.

DVDS

DVDs can be purchased for every youth camp session and are available at the end of every week for campers to take home. The DVD is approximately 10 minutes in length and includes the major highlights of the week's events plus some extras. Cost: \$10.

GIFT CERTIFICATES

A gift Certificate can be purchased online to help send someone to a retreat, summer camp, or family camp. You may pay with a credit card online and specify how much you are willing to gift.

PREPAID ACTIVITY OPTION

For campers wanting to add activities with additional cost (Horse Trail Ride, Paintball, Mtn Boards, etc), they may do so during check-in, or in advance using our Prepaid Activity Option form. This form will come with your camper's confirmation letter, as well as online at lbcc.com.

ROOMMATES

We will do our best to place campers in a cabin with their friends. However, campers need to indicate on their registration form the one friend they would like to room with during camp.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Many of our supporting churches provide financial assistance in whole or in part for families who cannot afford to send their kids to camp. 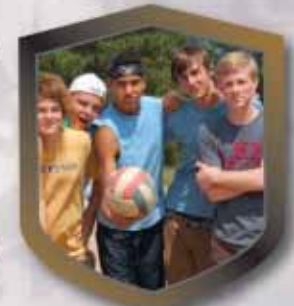
Speaker: Kara Stromberg
