**Job Title:** Wrangler (x2)

**Job Classification:** Summer Program Staff

**Organizational Relationships:**

- Directly reports to the Ranch Supervisor
- Indirectly reports to full-time program staff

**Position Overview:**

The Wranglers are responsible for assisting in the management of the Ranch at LBBC. The Wranglers accomplish this by performing regular care and maintenance of the horses and ranch equipment, preparing and leading all horse rides, teaching, and enforcing all safety and emergency standards according to LBBC policy, and by developing a fun atmosphere for all riders. The Wranglers are also responsible to assist with general program duties and with cabin leading duties.

**Job Tasks:**

- Care for the horses through regular feeding, watering, grooming, and training.
- Maintain all equipment at the Ranch.
- Learn all horse names and personalities to correctly assign to campers.
- Set up and tear down for all horse rides.
- Lead all trail rides for campers and guest groups and create a positive and safe riding experience.
- Enforce all necessary safety standards and procedures according to LBBC policy.
- Assist in general program duties (including, but not limited to, food service, housekeeping, and facilities) as assigned.
- When not performing program duties, assist in cabin leading duties in coordination with assigned cabin leader.
- All other duties as assigned.

**Desired Education and/or Experience:**

- High school diploma
- Some experience working with horses and livestock

**Desired Knowledge, Skill, and Ability:**

- Knowledge and ability to care for and safely interact with horses
- Knowledge and ability to handle high-stress situations calmly and confidently
- Knowledge and ability to perform basic training for horses
- Ability to effectively instruct guests to ride horses in a safe manner
- Ability to ride horses confidently and lead horse rides
- Ability to effectively lead, organize, and communicate in small groups of people from children to adults
- Ability to effectively disciple, mentor, and spiritually lead campers in a supporting role

- Current first-aid/CPR certification or willingness/availability to receive said certification
