

Job Title: Ropes Supervisor

Job Classification: Summer Supervisor Team Staff

Organizational Relationships:

- Directly Reports to Program Director / Program Coordinator

- Collaborates with Maintenance Team

- Oversees Ropes staff

Position Overview:

The Ropes Supervisor is responsible for the coordination and operation of the challenge course, vertical playground, and low ropes elements. The Ropes Supervisor accomplishes this by managing the ropes staff, coordinating with the Maintenance Team to complete regular maintenance and repairs of all equipment, and developing and executing relevant activities. The Ropes Supervisor is also responsible to assist with general program duties, as needed.

Job Tasks:

- Manage assigned ropes areas (challenge course, vertical playground, and low ropes elements) and oversee its staff.
- Assist in the training of ropes team staff to maintain, set up, operate, log, and tear down all
 assigned ropes areas for summer programming.
- Communicate maintenance needs to the Maintenance Team.
- Communicate supply concerns and needs to the Program Director.
- Keep assigned program areas clean, safe, and well-maintained throughout the summer.
- Bring filled water coolers and cups to the relevant area at the beginning of each session and return / wash them afterwards.
- Envision and promote ways to develop and expand Lake Beauty's activities.
- Assist in general program duties (including, but not limited to, food service, housekeeping, and facilities) as assigned.
- When not performing program duties, assist in cabin leading duties in coordination with assigned cabin leader.
- Perform Summer Supervisor Team duties in coordination with the Summer Supervisor Team.
- All other duties as assigned.
