## **Arrival & Check-In**

All guests MUST check in at the Welcome Center upon arrival.

## **Eagle Ridge Cabins – Edlund Retreat Center – Loon Lodge**

- Arrive after 9 AM on Friday (1<sup>st</sup> day).
- Guests provide their own bedding, towels, and personal care items.
- Outbaths for cabins are located in a separate nearby building.
- Edlund Guests: 1 full-size lower bunk, plus single bunks.
- Loon Guests: single beds and bunks.
- Cabin Guests: 1 queen-size lower bunk, plus single bunks.

## **Campgrounds**

- Thursday (Extra Day): begins at 1 PM.
- Friday (1<sup>st</sup> Day): begins at 9 AM.
- Mill Point, Cottonwood & Westwood sites are reserved by site number in advance.
- Lakeside camping area is on a first-come basis, with advanced reservation.

## **Check-Out**

Your balance is due at check-out with cash, check, e-check, or credit/debit card (most major cards accepted).

A 3% service fee is added for all registration charges paid by credit or debit card.

All guests MUST check out at the Welcome Center and depart from camp property by 3 PM on Monday.

## **Porta-Potties**

Porta-potties are available at Mill Point Campground (2), the Waterfront (1), and the Challenge Course (1).

## **Dumpsters**

Dumpsters are available for campground trash in Cottonwood/Mill Point Campgrounds (1) and Westwood Campground (1).

## **Camp Store**

Located in the Lakeview Dining Hall, our Lake Beauty Camp Store sells clothing, apparel, blankets, gifts, and personal care items (toothbrushes). Cash, checks, and credit cards are accepted. Please note that store purchases cannot be added to your camp account. Camp Store hours are listed on the front of this booklet.

## **Canteen**

The Canteen (Gym/Rec Center Porch; Outside Window) offers candy, ice cream, soda, and water. Cash only. See weekend schedule for hours.

## **Auction**

The Lake Beauty Family Camp Auction is a long-time tradition, with all proceeds going to the Camper Scholarship Fund. Items (baked goods, handmade items, furniture, etc.) for the auction can be dropped off at check-in. The auction will be held Saturday at 3:00 on the Back Porch of the Dining Hall.

## **Campground Trolley to Chapel**

A free trolley service is provided 30 minutes before each chapel session and passes through the various campground areas. The trolley makes 2–3 trips prior to chapel, and for safety/capacity reasons is ONLY for bringing guests to chapel, not riding just for fun.

## **Kids Camp**

LBBC offers "Kids Camp" for children up to age 8. Our summer staff provide age appropriate programming for kids, while parents attend chapel. Learn more about locations and age group breakdowns during check-in at the Welcome Center.

### **Kids Camp: Age 0-2 in Edlund Lower Lounge**

Babies and children will be dropped off at the basement of Edlund before chapel. Here, parents will check-in their child on a clipboard and are required to pick them up at the end of chapel.

### **Kids Camp: Age 3-5 -in Lakeview South**

Children between the ages of 3 and 5 will be dropped off at Lakeview South prior to chapel beginning. They will remain at this location for the entire duration of chapel. During check-in, guardians will receive a unique sticker that corresponds to a sticker placed on their child. This sticker must be present when picking your child up from Kids Camp.

### **Kids Camp: Age 4-8 - at Back Porch/Volleyball Pit (Gym if raining)**

Check-in your children at a table at chapel before chapel begins or during the first few songs. Here, guardians will receive a unique sticker corresponding to a sticker placed on their child. This sticker must be present when picking your child up from Kids Camp.

## **Emergency Info**

On-Call Staff Cell: (320) 247-5132. In the event of a fire or medical emergency:

1. Call 911.
2. Ask for the Long Prairie service area.
3. Inform them you are calling from **Lake Beauty Bible Camp**, located two miles North of HWY 27 on 315th Ave (Lake Beauty Road). Our physical address is **25766 Hummingbird Trail, Long Prairie, MN 56347**.
4. Our phone number is (320) 732-3218.
5. Alert camp staff so we can help and direct emergency service.

## **First Aid**

See Lake Beauty Staff for first aid. We have a defibrillator located in the Dining Hall. A 24-hour Emergency Room is 12 minutes away at the CentraCare Long Prairie Hospital (320-732-2141).

## **Fires**

A fire ring will be at your site or cabin (except for Lakeside, which you must request at check-in). Do not build fires without a ring. Firewood is available at no cost for our Family Camp guests in totes located throughout camp. Please do not bring wood from outside of camp. Fires should be completely extinguished when not attended.

## **Refuse, RV Dump Station, Smoking & Alcohol**

- Refuse can be placed in garbage or recycling containers throughout the grounds (usually near bathroom buildings).
- RV Dump Station is located across from the Welcome Center near the Mill Point Campground.
- Smoking is permitted only in personal vehicles or outside (at least 10 feet from camp buildings.)
- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on Lake Beauty grounds.

## **Vehicles**

- Speed Limit is 10 mph.
- Passengers will be inside vehicles (truck beds, running boards, trailers, etc. are not allowed).
- Golf Carts are not permitted. For guests with mobility issues, please call camp for approval.
- All vehicles must stay on the main roads.

## **Pets**

All pets must be registered. Please stop at the Welcome Center to register or register online.

- Dogs will not be off leash any time (including when attended at your site/cabin).
- Dogs will not be left unattended at your site/cabin or outside buildings.
- Dogs may not be on the beach or in any buildings.
- Owners must bag and dispose of dog waste immediately.

## **Picnic Tables**

One picnic table is provided at each campsite. Lakeside picnic tables are lined up near the playground and can be moved by guests or moved by a staff member upon request.

## Quiet Hours

Quiet hours are from 11 PM to 7 AM. We also encourage parents to be mindful of younger family members, especially during these quiet hours. Thank you!

## Ice & Water

- Cube ice is available for purchase at the Welcome Center.  
\$3 for a 5 lb bag. Pay with cash or charge to your account.
- Water faucets in Westwood & Lakeside campgrounds are located outside each outbath.
- Additional faucets are located at the Lakeview Dining Hall & Canteen Porch. *Do not wash your dishes in the outbath sinks.*

## Meals

If you wish to purchase meals, please notify the Camp Office by Monday at noon before your family camp session begins; see the website for menu options. A limited number of toddler chairs are located in the Dining Hall.

## Free Time Activities & Sign Ups

Many weekend activities (High Ropes Challenge Course, Laser Tag, Archery Tag) can be arranged by signing up at the Welcome Center or Camp Store. **This year there is no calling in for activity sign ups prior to checking in on Friday.** Check the schedule for sign-up hours, activity times, age requirements, and fees.

### Challenge Course

**Aerial High Ropes Course:** Challenge yourself on our high ropes obstacle course. The two levels and 16 elements are sure to test your physical limits! Must have a vertical reach of 72", weight limit of 50-250lbs that will be verified before taking part, and minimum age of 3rd grade to experience. Climbers must wear closed-toe shoes. Swimsuits are not allowed on the challenge course.

**Climbing Tower:** Climb our climbing tower on one of three rock-hold routes. Harnessed to a safety belay line, this is a personally challenging and rewarding experience. Climbers must wear closed-toe shoes. Swimsuits are not allowed on the Climbing Tower.

**Step of Faith:** 40 feet above the ground and secured to a giant pulley, step off... and drop! The pulley slows your descent and lowers you to the ground. Climbers must wear closed-toe shoes with a weight limit of 50-250lbs that will be verified before taking part. Swimsuits are not allowed on the Step of Faith.

### Vertical Playground

**Pamper Pole:** Climb our 30-foot pole, stand on the top, and jump out to ring the bell! Minimum age 6th grade. Climbers must wear closed-toe shoes. Swimsuits are not allowed on the vertical playground.

**Zip Line:** Currently unavailable due to storms.

### Laser Tag (\$10 per person)

A ton of fun and a great memory-maker! \$10 gets you an hour of play with family and friends. Open to ages 8 and up (ages 8-10 should be accompanied by an adult). Bug spray recommended.

Archery Tag (\$5 per person)

Imagine dodgeball with a bow and foam tipped arrow. Open to ages 13 and up. Closed-toe shoes are required. Bug spray recommended.

Fat Tire Bikes

Only available for guided bike rides.

## Waterfront Guidelines

Your safety and enjoyment are important to us. Please obey our basic waterfront guidelines.

1. Parents, be aware that your children always require proper supervision at the waterfront. **Swimming this weekend is at your own risk and must be supervised by parents; no lifeguards are on duty.**
2. Everyone using watercraft (Canoes, Kayaks, etc.) MUST wear a life jacket (available on the lakeside of the A-frame). Please return and hang up life jackets when you are done using them. Ensure the watercraft is put away properly (canoes on rack, other non-motorized boats near A-frame).
3. Operate all watercrafts outside the roped swim area; boats are not allowed in the swimming area.
4. LBBC watercraft are not meant for bumper boats; please do not bump them or switch patrons in the middle of the lake.
5. No glass or pets on the swimming beach.
6. No throwing rocks/stones/sand.
7. No fishing in the swimming area or from the swimming docks. Fishing is only at the fishing dock, located to the right of the swim area.
8. Personal watercraft may not be docked, loaded, or unloaded in the swimming area or from the swimming beach docks.
9. Swimmers must stay within the roped area to avoid watercraft.
10. Observe watercraft load limitations (1 to a kayak, 2-3 to a canoe, 1 to Corcl, 1 to GWAG).
11. Only 6 on the water features (Water mats, water trampoline). Adult supervision is required whenever these are in use. There is also no diving, flipping off, or swimming under the water features.
12. No running or diving off the docks. Severe injury or death could occur.
13. After dark, swimming is prohibited.
14. Please read & follow all additional posted guidelines at the waterfront.

## Boating on Lake Beauty

A public cement boat landing is located on the southeast corner of the lake. Exit out the south camp entrance and turn left (about 1/4 mile down the road).

Please remember to approach the camp's waterfront property slowly. While docking boats at the main beach area is prohibited, you may use the fishing dock to the south for loading and unloading. Thank you for not leaving boats unattended at the docks.

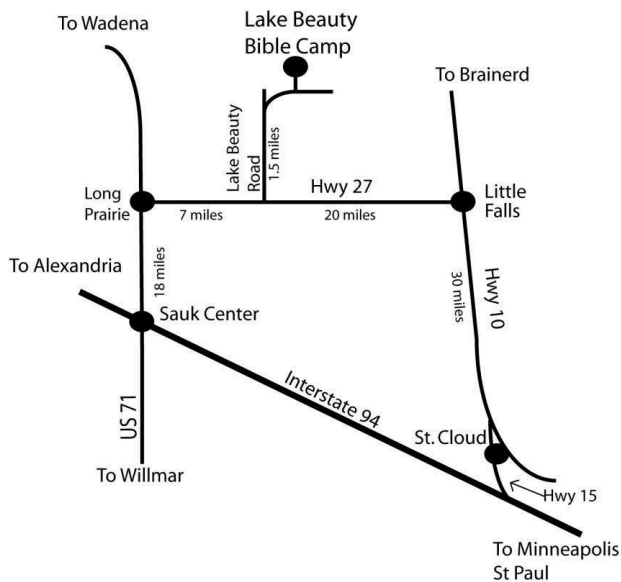
You may park your boat in the Welcome Center's grass parking area at night or whenever it is not used.

**Please Note: These guidelines are to keep all guests at the beach and on the lake safe. We reserve the right to close the waterfront for your safety if rules are not kept.**

## Directions

- Lake Beauty Bible Camp is located in Central MN 10 miles east of Long Prairie & 20 miles west of Little Falls. On MN Hwy 27, near mile marker 119, look for the road sign that reads: "Lake Beauty Bible Camp".
- Drive North 1 ½ miles on 315<sup>th</sup> Ave (Lake Beauty Rd) and turn right on Hummingbird Road at the large Lake Beauty rock.
- Continue a short distance to our sign & entrance turning left onto our camp road (Hummingbird Trail).
- Follow signs to the Welcome Center for check-in (all lodging).
