Registration and Check In:



Welcome to Lake Beauty Bible Camp and Summer Family Weekend #1! Here are a few FAQ's about the weekend:

1. What does check in and check out look like?

CHECK-IN for all lodging areas is at the Welcome Center near the entrance of camp (off Hummingbird Rd). Campgrounds – Thursday 12pm-8pm, Friday 9am-8pm

Cabins – Friday 3pm-8pm

CHECK-OUT is Sunday 8:30am-12pm at the Welcome Center. Final payment due at check-out.

2. What if we need to arrive after 8pm?

What to Know Before Arrival:

1. What is provided at campsites and cabins?

A picnic table and fire ring. Firewood is provided free of charge and is found at several convenient locations. Please do not bring firewood to Camp. Cabin guests need to bring their own bedding and towels. Modern bathrooms with showers are located in the cabin area, just a short walk from cabins.

2. Where will we eat?

Households will need to bring supplies to prepare and cook their own meals at campsites and cabins.

- 3. Can we bring beer, wine, or liquor? Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on our grounds.
- 4. What about smoking? Smoking is permitted only in personal vehicles or outside camp buildings.

5. Can we bring a dog?

Dogs:

- are welcome at your campsite and outdoors at your cabin.
- All dogs must be registered via our online form prior to arrival, or upon arrival.
- will be kenneled or leashed at all times.
- will be personally attended at all times (do not leave at campsite or cabin).
- are not allowed inside buildings (exception: registered service animal).
- waste must be bagged up and disposed of properly.

6. Do campsites have full hookups?

Mill Point – electric (50amp), water, sewer. Onboard bathrooms recommended.

Cottonwood – electric (50amp), water.

Westwood – electric (50amp).

Lakeside - light electric (10amp). Lakeside has its own bathroom.

NOTE: The Westwood Bathroom currently serves Westwood, Cottonwood & Mill Pt Guests.

7. Does camp have a dump station? The dump station is located across from the Welcome Center.

8. Can we use our personal vehicles to get around camp?

Yes:

- Speed Limit is 10mph.
- Passengers will be inside vehicles. For your safety, passengers in a truck bed must be sitting completely down in the bed with the tailgate up (riding on running boards, trailers, etc. are not allowed).

9. Can we bring a golf cart?

- No golf carts can be used on site.
- Guests with mobility issues please call camp for approval.

10. Can we bring a boat?

Yes, bring your personal watercraft. The public access is on Hummingbird Road. Trailer parking is available in designated areas at Camp. There is limited docking space. Please check in the office.

II. Is ice available? Bags of Ice Cubes (5lb & 20lb) can be picked up at the Welcome Center and charged to your bill.

Activities:

I. When can we sign up for activities?

Households may sign up by calling the office at 320-732-3218 beginning **Thursday, July 13**. You may also add activities during your stay by calling the camp office (open 7 days a week).

2. What activities will be available this weekend? Other than Pontoon Rental, all of the following are included in your weekend registration:

Friday activities

Challenge Course (up to 10 per hour, 48" tall is min height). 6pm, 7pm Tubing on the Torpedo (1-5 per ½ hour). 6pm, 6:30pm, 7pm, 7:30pm Pontoon Rental: \$40/hr

Saturday activities

Pontoon Rental: \$40/hr.

Laser Tag (K – adult, up to 22 players per session, closed toed shoes). 10am, 11am Challenge Course (see above). 1pm, 2pm, 3pm Step of Faith (1-7 per ½ hr session, closed toe shoes, 40lb-225lb required). 10am, 10:30am, 11am, 11:30am Tubing on the Torpedo (see above). 2pm, 2:30pm, 3pm, 3:30pm
