

Job Title: Photographer / A/V
Job Classification: Summer Staff

Organizational Relationships:

- Directly reports to Ministry Staff
- Indirectly reports to Program Director
- Coordinates with Worship Leader for A/V

Position Overview:

This position serves as the "eyes" and "ears" of camp. The photographer is responsible for taking pictures of each week's events and creating a weekly photo album. Along with this, the photographer is the primary A/V tech for chapel (running sounds & slides). This position is required to attend every event and photograph as many moments as possible, seeking to show camp through the camper's eyes. The Photographer is also responsible to assist with general program duties and with cabin leading duties, as needed.

Job Tasks:

- Coordinate photography of events and take pictures.
- Download and edit pictures daily (suggestion: pick a "top 50" of the day to edit and use)
 - A good picture: shows smiling faces, highlights fun, contains a lot of color, illustrates the beauty of camp, illuminates a variety of different faces, captures emotions of summer camp, explores uses of non-traditional angles
 - Delete unusable and duplicate photos
- Create a weekly photo album for each week of summer programming through Lake Beauty's third-party app.
- Assist in a summer recap video/photo collage.
- Maintain all photography equipment.
- Develop and promote ways to expand the use of visual technology in summer programming.

- Run sound and slides during the daily chapel sessions.
- Work alongside the Worship Leader in maintaining the laptop and ProPresenter
- Assist in general program duties (including, but not limited to, food service, housekeeping, and facilities) as assigned.
- When not performing program duties, assist in cabin leading duties in coordination with assigned cabin leader
- All other duties as assigned.
