



Job Title: Art Studio Leader

Job Classification: Summer Staff

Organizational Relationships:

- Directly reports to Program Director / Program Coordinator

Position Overview:

The Art Studio Leader is responsible for managing all aspects of the Art Studio. The Art Studio Leader accomplishes this by planning and leading crafts for campers, organizing and keeping the studio stocked with necessary supplies, and fostering an atmosphere that allows campers to be creative and have fun. The Art Studio Leader is also responsible to assist with general program duties, as needed.

Job Tasks:

- Assist in creation of the decoration ideas and implementation of that decoration for the summer theme (notably, chapel and dining hall decor, among others)
- Develop crafts for every age group that are related to the theme.
- Oversee the Art Studio during open times, including managing the cash box and tablet.
- Lead crafts during cabin times/rotations.
- Execute a weekly cleaning schedule for the Art Studio.
- Assist campers in making crafts and developing their artistic skills.
- Inventory craft supplies on a regular basis and communicate supply concerns/needs to the Program Director.
- Assist in general program duties (including, but not limited to, food service, housekeeping, and facilities) as assigned.
- When not performing program duties, assist in cabin leading duties in coordination with assigned cabin leader.
- All other duties as assigned.
