

Job Title: Videographer

Job Classification: Summer Staff

Position Overview:

The Videographer is responsible for capturing, creating, and developing video content for summer programming. The Videographer accomplishes this by operating and maintaining visual equipment, producing multimedia presentations, and collaborating with other staff to showcase camp experiences. The Videographer is expected to attend events and record moments that reflect camp through the camper's perspective. The Videographer is also responsible to assist with general program duties, as needed.

Job Tasks:

- Record videos of summer activities and organize all material for use in videos, brochures, social media, and other camp communications.
- Create weekly recap videos by session and a summer recap video for promotional use.
- Oversee and develop a W.O.W. ("Words of Wisdom") video that incorporates the summer theme and involves summer staff.
- Produce 2x weekly Instagram reels.
- Maintain all video equipment and ensure it is ready for use.
- Communicate supply concerns and needs to the Program Director.
- Develop and promote ways to expand the use of visual technology in summer programming.
- Collaborate with the Photographer / A/V and Worship Leader to coordinate multimedia efforts.
- Demonstrate a willingness to learn new video and A/V techniques and apply them throughout the summer.
- Assist in general program duties (including, but not limited to, food service, housekeeping, and facilities) as assigned.
- When not performing program duties, assist in cabin leading duties in coordination with assigned cabin leader.
- All other duties as assigned.
