Arrival & Check-In/Check-out

Your balance is due at check-out with cash, check, e-check, or credit/debit card (most major cards accepted). A 3% service fee is added for all registration charges paid by credit or debit card.

Eagle Ridge Cabins – Edlund Retreat Center – Loon Lodge

- Arrive after 9:00 AM on Friday (1st day).
- Check in at the Welcome Center near the main entrance.
- Guests provide their own bedding, towels, and personal care items.
- Outbaths for cabins are located in a separate nearby building.
- Parking location will be provided during check-in.
- Edlund Guests: 1 full-size lower bunk, plus single bunks.
- Loon Guests: single beds and bunks
- Cabin Guests: 1 queen size lower bunk, plus single bunks.

Campgrounds

- Check in at the Welcome Center near the main entrance.
- Thursday (Extra Day): begins at 12:00 PM.
- Friday (1st Day): begins at 9:00 AM.
- Mill Point, Cottonwood & Westwood sites are reserved by site number in advance.
- Lakeside camping area is on a first-come basis, with advanced reservation.

Porta Potties

Porta potties are available at Mill Point Campground (2), the Waterfront (1), and the Challenge Course (1).

Camp Store

Located in the Lakeview Dining Hall, our Lake Beauty Camp Store has a variety of hats, shirts, sweatshirts & blankets, as well as gifts and personal care items (toothbrushes, lip balm, etc). Cash, check, and credit cards accepted. Please note that store purchases cannot be added to your campwise account. Camp Store hours listed on front of this booklet.

Canteen

A variety of candy, ice cream, pop & water are available at the Canteen (Rec Center Porch–Outside Window) during scheduled hours.

Campground Trolley to Chapel

A free trolley service is provided 15 min before each Chapel session and passes through the various campground areas. Trolley makes 2-3 trips prior to chapel.

Kids Kamp: Age 0-2

Babies and children will be dropped off at the basement of Edlund prior to chapel. Here, parents will check-in their child on a clipboard and are required to pick them up at the end of chapel.

Kids Kamp: Age 3-5 - NEW

Children between the ages of 3-5 will be dropped off at their location (this will be announced when you check in for your weekend) prior to chapel beginning. Children will remain at this location for the entire duration of chapel. During check in, guardians will receive a unique sticker that corresponds to a sticker placed on their child. This sticker needs to be present when picking up your child from Kids Kamp.

Kids Kamp: Age 6-11 - NEW

Check-in your children at a table located in the back of the chapel before chapel begins or during the first few songs. Here, guardians will receive a unique sticker that corresponds to a sticker placed on their child. This sticker needs to be present when picking up your child from Kids Kamp.

Emergency Info

On Call Staff Cell: (320) 247-5132. In the event of a fire or medical emergency:

1. Call 911
2. Ask for Long Prairie service area
3. Inform them you are calling from **Lake Beauty Bible Camp** located two miles North of HWY 27 on 315th Ave (Lake Beauty Road). Our physical address is **25766 Hummingbird Trail, Long Prairie, MN 56347**.
4. Our phone number is (320) 732-3218.
5. Alert camp staff so we can help and direct emergency service.

Smoke Detectors & Fire Extinguishers

Retreat centers and cabins are equipped with smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors as specified by MN law. Fire extinguishers are located throughout the camp. In the event of a fire, ask LBBC Staff for assistance if you are unable to locate or properly operate an extinguisher.

First Aid

See Lake Beauty Staff for first aid. We have a defibrillator located in the Dining Hall. A 24-hour Emergency Room is 12 minutes away at the CentraCare Long Prairie Hospital (320-732-2141).

Fire Rings & Firewood

Everyone loves a campfire! A fire ring will be at your site or cabin (except for Lakeside-request at check-in). Please do not build fires without a ring.

Firewood is available at no cost for our Family Camp guests. Help slow the spread of tree damaging pests by leaving your wood at home. Totes of firewood are located throughout camp.

Refuse, RV Dump Station, Smoking & Alcohol

- Refuse can be placed in garbage or recycling containers located throughout the grounds (usually near bathroom buildings).
- RV Dump Station is across from the Welcome Center near the Mill Pt Campground.
- Smoking is permitted only in personal vehicles or outside (at least 10 feet from camp buildings.)
- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on Lake Beauty grounds.

Vehicles

- Speed Limit is 10 mph.
- Passengers will be inside vehicles (truck beds, running boards, trailers, etc. are not allowed).
- Golf Carts are not permitted. For guests with mobility issues - please call camp for approval.

Pets

All pets must be registered. Please stop at the Welcome Center to register or register online.

- Dogs will not be off leash any time (including when attended at your site/cabin).
- Dogs will not be left unattended at your site/cabin or outside buildings.
- Dogs may not be on the beach or in any buildings.
- Owners must scoop up after their dogs (please have bags with you).

Picnic Tables

Picnic tables are available upon request—one per family.

Quiet Hours

Quiet hours are from 11 pm to 7 am. We also encourage parents to be mindful of younger family members, especially during these quiet hours. Thank you!

Ice & Water

- Cube ice is available for purchase at the Welcome Center.
- Water faucets in Westwood & Lakeside campgrounds are located outside each outbath.
- Additional faucets are located at the Lakeview Dining Hall & Canteen Porch. Do not wash your dishes in the outbath sinks.

Meals

Meals are served buffet style in Lakeview Dining Hall. If you wish to purchase meals, please notify the Camp Office by Monday Noon before your family camp session begins. Call the office or see the rates sheet on the website for meal rates. See website for menu. A limited number of toddler chairs are located in the Dining Hall.

Free Time Activities & Sign Ups

Many weekend activities (High Ropes Challenge Course, Laser Tag, Archery Tag, Pontoon Lake Tour) are available by signing up at the Welcome Center or Camp Store or calling 320-732-3218 prior to check-in. Check the schedule for sign-up hours and activity times, age requirements, and fees.

- Trained LBBC facilitators are provided and required on ALL Challenge Course elements. Closed-toed shoes are required.
- Pay attention to age & weight restrictions.
- *Sign up in advance.*
- Please respect *Keep Off* signs.

Challenge Course

- **Aerial High Ropes Course** - Challenge yourself on our high ropes obstacle course. 2 levels and 16 elements are sure to test your physical limits! Must have completed 3rd grade.
- **Climbing Tower** - Climb our climbing tower on one of three rock-hold routes. Harnessed to a safety belay line, this is a personally challenging and rewarding experience.
- **Step of Faith** - 40 feet above the ground and secured to a giant pulley, step off...and drop! The pulley slows your descent and lowers you to the ground.

Vertical Playground

- **Giant's Ladder** - You and a friend climb to the sky! This team building activity requires 2 people to help each other up the rungs that are farther apart the higher you climb.
- **Giant's Web** - Climb our giant cargo net as fast as you can, trying to touch all the objects while going up, down and side-to-side.
- **Pamper Pole** - Climb our 30ft pole, stand on the top, and jump out to ring the bell! For those who have completed 5th grade or above.

Pontoon Lake Tour – Meet at Pontoon Dock

Enjoy a leisurely 30 minute cruise around Lake Beauty! Staff hosted. Life jackets provided. Room for 12 guests per excursion. *Sign up in advance.*

Pontoon Rental (\$40/hour)

Rent one of Lake Beauty's pontoons and enjoy the lake with your own driver. Lifejackets provided. Room for max of 12. *Sign up in advance.*

Laser Tag (\$10 per person) – Meet in front of Gym

A ton of fun and a great memory-maker! \$10 gets you an hour of play with family and friends. Open to Kindergarten and up. Closed-toed shoes required.

Archery Tag (\$10 per person) – Meet at Dining Hall Flagpole

Open to all 10 yrs-Adult (ages 10-13 must play with a parent/guardian). Closed-toed shoes required.

Waterfront Guidelines

Your safety and enjoyment are important to us. Please obey our basic waterfront guidelines.

1. Parents, be aware that your children always require proper supervision at the waterfront. **Swimming this weekend is at your own risk and must be supervised by parents, no lifeguards are on duty.**
2. Everyone using watercraft (Canoes, Kayaks, etc) MUST wear a life jacket (available in the lakeside of the A-frame). Please return and hang up life jackets when you are done using them. Make sure the watercraft is put away in the proper location (canoes on rack, other non-motorized boats near A-frame).
3. Operate all watercrafts outside the roped swim area; boats are not allowed in the swimming area.
4. LBBC watercraft are not meant for bumper boats: please do not bump them or switch patrons in the middle of the lake.
5. No glass or pets on the swimming beach.
6. No throwing rocks/stones/sand.
7. No fishing in the swimming area or from the swimming docks. Fishing is only at the fishing dock, located to the right of the swim area.
8. No docking/loading or unloading of personal watercraft in the swimming area or from the swimming beach docks.

9. Swimmers must stay within the roped area to avoid watercraft.
10. Observe watercraft load limitations (1 to a kayak, 2-3 to a canoe, 1 to Corcl, 1 to WGWAG).
11. Only 6 at a time on the water features (The Aqua Playground, Water mats, Spin wheel). Adult supervision is required whenever these are in use. There is also no diving, flipping off, or swimming under the water features.
12. No running or diving off the docks. Severe injury or death could occur.
13. After dark, swimming is prohibited.
14. Please read & follow all additional posted guidelines at the waterfront.

Boating on Lake Beauty

A public cement boat landing is located on the southeast corner of the lake – exit out the south camp entrance and turn left (about 1/4 mile down the road).

Please remember to approach the camp's waterfront property slowly. While docking boats at the main beach area is prohibited, you may use the fishing dock to the south for loading and unloading. Thank you for not leaving boats unattended at the docks.

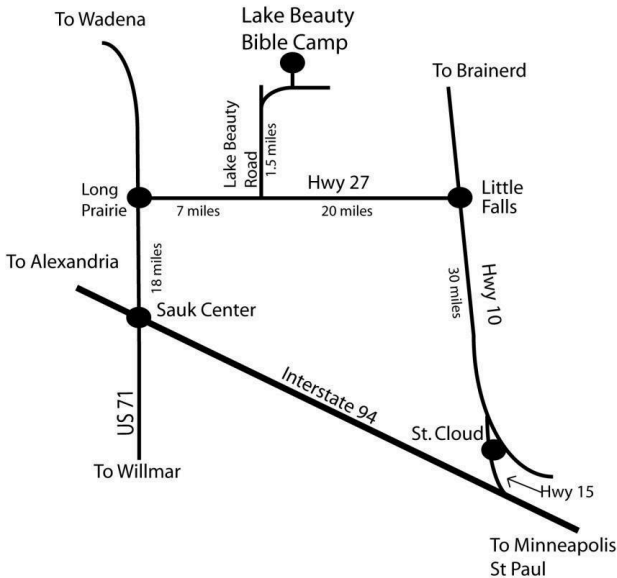
You may use the Welcome Center grass parking area to park your boat during the night or whenever your boat is not used.

Please Note: These guidelines are to keep all guests at the beach and on the lake safe. If rules are not kept, we reserve the right to close the waterfront for your safety.

Directions

- Lake Beauty Bible Camp is located in Central MN 10 miles east of Long Prairie & 20 miles west of Little Falls. On MN Hwy 27, near mile marker 119, look for the road sign that reads: “Lake Beauty Bible Camp”.
- Drive North 1 ½ miles on 315th Ave (Lake Beauty Rd) and turn right on Hummingbird Road at the large Lake Beauty rock.
- Continue a short distance to our sign & entrance turning left onto our camp road (Hummingbird Trail).
- Follow signs to the Welcome Center for check-in (all lodging).
