

Job Title: Cabin Leader

Job Classification: Summer Staff

Organizational Relationships:

- Directly reports to Head Cabin Leader

- Indirectly reports to Ministry Staff
- Indirectly reports to Program Director

Position Overview:

The Cabin Leader is responsible for the management of all campers within their assigned cabin. The Cabin Leader accomplishes this by leading the cabin spiritually, relationally, and logistically, leading and participating in all cabin activities, and by enforcing safety and disciplinary procedures according to LBBC policy. The Cabin Leader is also responsible to assist with general program duties, as assigned.

Job Tasks:

- Attend to the physical, mental, and spiritual needs of each camper.
- Develop mentoring relationships with each camper through intentional one-on-ones.
- Develop a healthy and positive culture within the cabin.
- Ensure that campers follow the camp schedule.
- Lead and participate with the campers in cabin activities.
- Create and lead cabin devotionals tailored to the theme and the camper's needs.
- Enforce disciplinary and safety standards and guidelines according to LBBC policy.
- Write thoughtful postcards and church evaluations at the end of each week for each camper.
- When not performing cabin leading duties, assist in general program duties (including, but not limited to, food service, housekeeping, and facilities) as assigned.
- All other duties as assigned.

- Knowledge and ability to understand the physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual needs of campers.
- Knowledge and ability to lead and teach campers spiritually.
- Knowledge and ability to handle disciplinary matters calmly and confidently.
- Ability to foster a positive and encouraging culture within a cabin.
- Ability to effectively lead, organize, and communicate with small groups of campers.
- Ability to effectively disciple, mentor, and spiritually lead campers in a primary role
