Job Title: Cabin Leader

Organizational Relationships:

- Reports to Head Cabin Leader
- Reports to Ministry Staff

Position Overview:

The Cabin Leader is responsible for the management of all campers within their assigned cabin. The Cabin Leader accomplishes this by leading the cabin spiritually, relationally, and logistically, participating/leading all cabin activities, and by enforcing safety and disciplinary procedures according to LBBC policy. The Cabin Leader is also responsible to assist with general program duties.

Job Tasks:

- Attend to the physical, mental, and spiritual needs of each camper.
- Develop mentoring relationships with each camper through intentional one-to-ones.
- Develop a healthy and positive culture within the cabin.
- Ensure that campers follow the camp schedule.
- Lead and participate with the students in cabin activities.
- Create and lead cabin devotionals tailored to the theme and the camper's needs.
- Enforce disciplinary and safety standards and guidelines according to LBBC policy.
- Write Christmas postcards and church evaluations for each camper.
- When not performing cabin leading duties, assist in general program duties (including, but not limited to, food service, housekeeping, and facilities) as assigned.
- All other duties as assigned.

Desired Education and/or Experience:

- Highschool Diploma
- Previous experience working with kids and youth.

Desired Knowledge, Skill, and Ability:

- Knowledge and ability to understand the physical, mental, and spiritual needs of campers.

- Knowledge and ability to lead and teach campers spiritually.
- Knowledge and ability to handle disciplinary matters calmly and confidently.
- Ability to foster a positive and encouraging culture within a cabin.
- Ability to effectively lead, organize, and communicate with small groups of campers.
- Ability to effectively disciple, mentor, and spiritually lead campers in a primary role
