Variation of a Fence Rail Quilt BEGINNER 59"x74"







This **beginner** level class is perfect for the first-time quilter and for those wishing to establish a firmer foundation of quilting basics. The instructors will guide you, step by step, in making this lap-sized quilt. All instruction will focus on accuracy in measuring, cutting, and sewing. Upon completing this class, you will have a good foundation for making other quilts.

YARDAGE AND FABRIC KEY

To help you remember which fabric goes where, we recommend that you add samples of your fabrics to this color palette.

Sample	Key Placement	Amt	Cut (<i>width of fabric</i>)	Suggestions
	A Focus Block	1 3/4 yards	(6) 9 1/2" strips Sub-cut 20 (9 1/2" squares)	This is a great opportunity to showcase scenery, novelty prints or larger print fabric.
	B Small Block	1/2 yard	(2) 6 1/2" strip. Sub-cut (12) 6 1/2" squares	Complimentary or contrasting fabric work nicely
	C Middle Rail Binding Backing	6 2/3 yard	1 Rail: (6) 3 1/2" strips Binding: (7) 2 1/2" strips	C forms the middle section of your "rails." A print or a solid will work well here. C also makes up your binding and backing.
	D Outer Rails & Border		2 yards	2 Rails: (12) 3 1/2" strips Border: (7) 3" strips.
